## New Orienteering Set to Begin

- The membership will be **voting on proposed bylaw changes** at the annual meeting on April 13th. This is the result of preliminary plans to change our nonprofit status.
- The club was one of 20 outdoors organizations to participate in the inaugural **WNY Wild Expo** in February. Over 130 people attended. Children completed a simple orienteeing activity and learned how to use a compass. Adults were given information on the sport and our events.

### 2013 Map Hike Information

Map Hikes are orienteering courses that can be completed at your own pace. This year there will be courses offered at Chestnut Ridge, Emery, Sprague Brook, Hunter's Creek, and Sardinia. All courses are new each year and feature 25 controls of varying difficulty. Courses are currently being set and packets will be available for purchase in April. Packets can be purchased at club events, Hyatt's stores, [hyatts.com](http://hyatts.com), the Gear For Adventure store, or via mail using the order form on page 7. When ordered through the Club, a discount is available when purchasing all five packets. Map hikes will remain in place through the end of February 2014.

Plans are underway this year to offer an **additional Map Hike in the Ellicottville area** that will remain in place for two seasons. It will feature our new 1:10,000 map. Check the website soon for details.
