### Treasurer's Report

In 2015 the club had revenues of \$11,773 and expenses of \$5327 for a profit of \$6446. Our most productive event was the Ellicottville Adventure Run and Hike which raised \$2236. We ended the year with \$26,364 in the bank.

For 2016 we anticipate much higher expenses than last year because of the expansion of the Ellicottville map to the south to include the Rock City State Forest. This project is expected to cost about \$14,000. Additional mapping projects at Knox Farm, Camp Schoellkopf, and Hunter's Creek have also been authorized at a cost of \$2000.

map at Knox Farm State Park. Our Ellicottville map has been extended south to include Little Rock City and beyond and will be used at next year's Adventure Run. An update of Hunter's Creek is also planned for the spring.

## ***Orienteering is Cunning Running!***

### **The Results Crew Is In Need Of More Volunteers**

If you've been to an event, you have noticed the person with the computer inputting your info into the results system, handing out your dibbler then directing you to download after you finish. It's an easy job to learn and we could use a few more people to do it.

It isn't hard to learn the software involved. There are two programs. One is used to configure the controls, the blue boxes that go out in the woods. That one is called "SIConfig." The other program, "Or" is used to calculate and display the results.

Whoever's in charge of the results for an event uses SIConfig about a week ahead of time to synchronize the clocks in all the controls. The person laying out the course maps sends a file that specifies the controls and their order on each course. This file is generated automatically by the course setting software and is also loaded into Or automatically. The results person then runs a test of each course to make sure all the boxes are working properly. The boxes are then passed to the organizer to be put into the woods.

On the day of the event, the results person brings the computer and the "stadium" controls (the start, finish, clear, and check) to the event. Registering people is simple data entry. When they finish you direct them to the download box. After the event the electronics person is responsible for sending the results to Greg so they can be posted on our website. And that's all there is to it.
