## CALENDAR

- Nov 5 B.O.C. Night Orienteering Meet. A first for Western New York! Location: Chestnut Ridge Park. Registration at 6:30 p.m. at the Casino. Start at 7:00 p.m. Bring a flashlight with fresh batteries. Two courses. Entry fee, \$1. for all. No novice instruction. Directions to the park: From the thruway, exit onto route 219 southbound at exit 55. Get off 219 at Armor-Duells Corners Road. Follow signs to the park. The maps are black & white, scale 1:10,000. Meet Director: Richard Fruehauf 833-7696.
- Nov 7 Indian Summer "B" Meet. At Brock University in St. Catharines, Ontario. The map scale is 1:10,000. Contour interval is 3 meters. Master maps will be used. Map cases can be purchased for 25¢. Start time is 11 a.m. Registration is 10:00-11:30 a.m. Three courses: long, medium, and short. A beginner's clinic is available upon request. Fees: Senior \$2.50; Junior (18 & under) \$2.00; Wayfarer's \$3.00. Compass rental, \$1.00. I.O.F. symbolic descriptions on medium and long courses, written descriptions on short course. Ribbons will be awarded. The usual Indian sun dances will be held beforehand to ensure the usual fine weather for this meet. Directions to meet site: Follow Q.E.W. to St. Catharines and exit on Ontario Street South (exit #47); follow Ontario Street South to Glenridge Avenue. Follow Glenridge south to Brock campus.
