

Dear friends! Hello from Moscow!

Writing you is Bourba Pavel, the coach of Moscow University o-team. We have got your address and some information concerning your o-club from Anne Buraczynski from USOF this summer.

We are very interested in contacts between sportsmen and o-clubs of our two countries and now **Moscow University orienteers invite your o-club to Moscow**. You will be able to get sightseeings and city excursions in Moscow (and, if desirable, in Leningrad), to visit museums and to take part in o-events and o-trainings together with our club. We are ready to provide completely your stay in the USSR including meals and accommodation problems.

Well, if there is something interesting in our suggestion our cooperation may be based either on:

- a) mutual exchange by o-teams or
- b) commercial basis.

In case a) after your visit to Moscow we will be glad to take part in some o-events or trainings in NY (1991 or next year). Since our o-club is the student team we are ready to any accommodation conditions in USA (up to tent camping). Accommodation in Moscow also will not be very expensive.

In case b) the reception problems concerned our visit to USA will not trouble you if you cover expenses of your accommodation in Moscow. Since your club may be the first USA o-team visiting Moscow you shouldn't pay much - no more than \$35 for person per day. It should be noted that this price is 3 times cheaper than the prices of other Moscow tourist and sport official organizations.

We suggest the following dates:

-your visit: 04-13 of July 1991 (it is just before the FIN-5 and O-RINGEN; you can use train to Finland and Sweden from Moscow or Leningrad)

-our visit: October-November 1991 or 1992.

Some our orienteers dream to **organize (or to take part in) o-map drawing** anywhere in USA. Next summer we are ready to work without any remuneration if our expenses in USA will be covered. If you can help us with an invitation or if you have any information (addresses of organizations to contact with), please write me this winter.
