

### LONG-O AND NYS CHAMPSIONSHIP REPORT By Dave Cady

It was an opportunity too good to pass up. Imagine a Two-Day A-meet, a U.S. Championship, and the NYS Championships all on the same weekend and all within an hour and a half drive from Buffalo. Eleven BflO members decided to take advantage of that opportunity presented on the first weekend in November by the Rochester O Club.

Day One was held at Letchworth State Park on the now familiar but still challenging map of the southwest end. The choice was to enter the U.S. Long-O Championship or to run on a regular length A-meet course. The Long-O courses were 50% to 75% longer than the standard courses.

On Day Two, Charles Bentz finished first in M45B on Green.
