ORIENTEERING SKILLS CLINIC

Saturday, September 23, 1995 Sardinia Forest

The purpose of this clinic is to teach the novice orienteer skills that will be needed on intermediate level courses. Pre-requisites for this clinic include having participated on two white (or ..beginner..) courses, or one yellow course, and familiarity with the following:

- 1. map symbols,
- 2. how to orient the map using a compass,
- 3. meet procedures.

Skills to be taught include some or all of the following:

- 1. pace counting,
- 2. taking bearings,
- 3. use of attack points,
- 4. recognizing collecting features,
- 5. aiming off,
- 6. reading contours,
- 7. understanding symbolic control descriptions.

The clinic runs from 10:30 am until 3 pm and will be held rain or shine. Participants should come dressed for activity in the woods and should bring a bag lunch. Coolers will be provided.

There is no charge for the clinic but participants must be members of the Buffalo Orienteering Club and must pre-register by 9 pm September 20th.
