What is a Map Hike?

1. Each spring, the **Buffalo Orienteering Club** sets up a course of 15 to 25 controls at several Parks for the avid orienteer or the casual hiker to experience orienteering at their leisure. They remain up until February of the following year.
2. The MAP HIKES are set up at Erie County's Chestnut Ridge Park, Emery Park, Hunters Creek Park, Sardinia County Forest, and Sprague Brook Park and at Knox Farm State Park.

How To Do It?

1. The location of the red and white control that you are at is represented on the MAP HIKE map by a red circle and number that matches the control number.
2. The control card that comes in the MAP HIKE packets has numbered boxes to record the control codes.
3. "Map Hiking" is a great family or group activity. Controls can be visited in any order and at any time during the 2021 season.
